

Operating Principles of Cheltenham Film Society

- Members are the Society and elect the Committee to run it on their behalf (including comfort, health and safety, and well-being), delivering the promise made on the application form and developed over time.
- The Committee will at all times be responsible for the smooth running of the Society. This will be done through collaborative Committee working, with all members being supportive externally once a decision is made. All decisions can be reviewed at the Annual Review or if needs dictate. On occasions, especially during the renewal process, Committee decisions may not always be possible and tactical decisions may need to be taken by the Chair/Secretary.
- The Committee will undertake an Annual Review of the past season at which any issue can be discussed, including: proposals for the format of the following season, including length, any cap on membership numbers, membership costs, CFS Extra, etc; and any innovation events, beginning in April 2020.
- Committee members are encouraged to bring costed proposals for Committee discussion on any ideas to run events ourselves, support local third parties or indeed potentially to be able to accommodate more members.
- Volunteering for the CFS Committee and associated bodies such as the Viewing Committee should at all times be an enjoyable experience.
